About Neighbors Serving Neighbors

Neighbors Serving Neighbors is a registered 501(c)(3) food pantry based in Bartlett, Texas. We serve 400 families (1,200 individuals) across Williamson, Bell, & Milam counties every month.

Our mission is simple: Neighbors feeding neighbors. We believe no one in our community should have to choose between a meal and an electric bill.

Your Company's Impact

Every pound collected helps provide meals to local families. On average, 1 pound of food helps provide approximately 1 meal.

Example Impact provides 3-5 meals a week:

- 1 person: ~10–15 pounds of food per week
- Family of 4: ~40–60 pounds of food per week

Suggested Drive Models

- **"Casual for Cans":** Allow employees to wear jeans or a relaxed outfit in exchange for a donation of 3–5 items.
- **The Department Duel:** Create a friendly competition between Sales, Marketing, and HR. The winning team gets a catered lunch or an extra hour of "early-out" time on Friday.
- **Corporate Matching:** Challenge the business owner to match every 10 pounds of food collected with a \$10 donation to the pantry.

- **The "Meal Kit" Challenge:** Encourage employees to bring in bundles like "Pasta Night" (noodles + sauce + canned veggies), "Sunday Supper" (canned beef, instant potatoes, canned veggies), "Taco Tuesday" (canned chili, boxed corn shells, salsa)

Most Needed Items

- Canned vegetables and fruit
- Peanut butter
- Rice and pasta
- Cereal and oatmeal
- Canned tuna or chicken
- Beans (dry or canned)
- Mac & cheese
- Soup and chili
- Shelf-stable milk
- Personal Care: Toilet paper, soap, and feminine hygiene products (items SNAP doesn't cover).

Please avoid expired or opened items.

What We Provide

- **Collection Bins:** We drop off and pick up bins so your foyer stays tidy.
- **Marketing Materials:** We provide digital graphics for your social media, employee newsletter, and PowerPoint slides.
- **Impact Reporting:** Within 48 hours of pick-up, we will send you the total weight collected and the number of families those donations will feed so you can celebrate the win with your employees.
